Standardized Dress Information



The following standardized dress guidelines will be implemented at Beneke Elementary. All students will participate in the standardized dress requirements..

 Parents, who do not wish their child(ren) to wear the required standardized dress must provide a written statement of a bona fide religious objection or philosophical objection to the principal of Beneke Elementary School. The principal will discuss the objection with the parent. The principal shall determine if the objection is acceptable and valid.

 Funding for implementation will be provided through the campus student activity account, private donations from the community, and campus vendor funds (particularly vendor funds associated with the sale of customized school clothing).

 The school administrators will meet with those families requesting assistance due to economic reasons and shall determine if the student is "Educationally Disadvantaged".

 **The look of standardized dress at Beneke Elementary will be:**

Pants -- khaki, navy twill, and blue denim jeans; fitted at the waist
Jumpers, Skirts, Skorts, or Shorts -- khaki, navy blue, or blue denim;
a length approaching the knee; belted (if belt loops are present)
Shirts/Blouses -- solid red, white, or navy blue; long or short sleeves;
collars; no emblems; and tucked in unless banded like a sweatshirt or
sweater.
