

SHERIDAN ELEMENTARY'S STANDARDIZED DRESS CODE

SHIRTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • solid primary red, white, navy blue, and royal blue • shirts must be tucked in unless the waist band of the shirt is ribbed • styles include button down, turtle neck, pull-over, peter-pan, polo style • sweatshirts, sweaters, windbreakers follow the same color guidelines as shirts • long or short sleeves • no sleeveless shirts or tank tops • must be free of logos, trims, & decorations
PANTS SHORTS JUMPERS SKIRTS SKORTS DRESSES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • solid navy blue or khaki • no denim or jean material • no leggings, sweatpants, windpants, or athletic shorts • length of shorts, skorts, dresses, etc. finger tips or longer • fitted at waist and crotch
BELTS GRADES 1 - 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • coordinating belts must be worn with clothing that has belt loops • belts should be solid black, brown, primary red, white, navy blue, or khaki
SOCKS OR TIGHTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • solid primary red, white, navy blue or royal blue • no logos
SHORTS UNDER CLOTHING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be worn under skirts or dresses • navy blue or khaki
SHOES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • tennis shoes or flats with rubber soles that are appropriate for PE and recess must be worn • unacceptable shoes include jellies, open-toed sandals, backless slides and shoes with heels higher than one inch
OUTERWEAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • can be any color or design if it is stored in the coat cabinet • sweaters, sweatshirts and windbreakers, if worn indoors, must be solid primary red, white, navy blue or royal blue (no logos)
FRIDAYS & SPECIAL DAYS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • spirit shirts or solid primary red, white, navy blue or royal blue shirts may be worn with <u>solid blue</u> jeans or <u>solid blue denim</u> shorts, skirts, or skorts • girls and boy scout uniforms may be worn • 5th grade DARE shirts on DARE day • individual choice on individual picture and spring portrait days

These clothes do not have to be purchased from a specific vendor to fit the dress code.

There will be a compliance period of 10 days for move-in families. Non-compliance will follow the consequences defined by the Student Code of Conduct.

All other rules and regulations as defined in the Student Code of Conduct regarding dress and grooming will apply.
