

Chisholm Trail Middle School Standardized Dress Guidelines

The standardized dress policy at Chisholm Trail Middle School will offer choices but will be limited to:

GIRLS:

1. Pants, Capri pants, walking shorts, skorts or skirts to the knee or longer in khaki or denim (blue or black)
2. Collared shirts, short or long sleeve, in red, white, black, or gray. The shirts must be in a solid color, free of logos, prints, or brand names.
3. Any school sponsored T-shirt.
4. In the winter, sweatshirts, pullover sweaters, or vests in the same four basic colors with no logos may be worn.

BOYS:

1. Pants or long walking shorts in khaki or denim (blue or black)
2. Collared shirts, short or long sleeve, in red, white, black, or gray. The shirts must be in a solid color free of logos, prints, or brand names.
3. Any school sponsored T-shirt.
4. In the winter, sweatshirts, pullover sweaters, or vests in the same four basic colors with no logos may be worn.

No spandex, sweats, wind pants, sagging or oversized apparel or jackets will be worn to classes. The only apparel items allowed over regular shirts are sweatshirts with no logos, pullover sweaters, or vests. Jackets may be worn to school but must be left in the locker during the day unless the students have classes in the portable buildings.

Logos on shirts or sweaters will not be allowed unless they are school sponsored. Any logos on pants, skirts, skorts, or walking shorts may not be visible from the front and may be allowed only on the rear waistband or pocket as designed by the manufacturer.

- ❖ The CTMS student council will sponsor several dress up and theme days throughout the year. These special days will be posted in the school calendar every six weeks.
